Deadline: 07/15/2022

Eligibility: Applicants must:

- Be a Class of 2022 high school graduate.
- Have a permanent residence in New Castle County, Delaware.
- Must have been accepted and plan to attend an accredited and approved four-year institution in Fall 2022.
- Demonstrate a dedication to community service.
- Must have graduated high school with a cumulative 2.75 GPA
- Applicants must submit a transcript with the essay.
- 2. **Essay:** The lessons we take from obstacles we encounter can be fundamental to later success. Recount a time when you faced a challenge, setback, or failure. How did it affect you, and what did you learn from the experience? **Minimum 500 words, typed, double spaced, size 12 font, word document.**

Award: Two (2) \$500 scholarships, one time award.
